In an effort to keep our students informed of the admissions requirements as determined by the Health Technologies division, **all applicants are required to attend an Allied Health Information Session either in-person or online.** This session will provide you with valuable information that will assist you with the selective admissions process. It will also allow you to receive the most recent information regarding admissions requirements.

If you choose to complete the online information session, you are required to submit the electronic signature form via mail, email, fax, or hand delivery. Keep in mind that the in-person information session is recommended but no longer a mandatory requirement.

If you have previously attended a session but were not accepted to a health curriculum, you must reapply, complete a new Allied Health Information Session (in-person or online) <u>and</u> complete a MAR Review if you wish to be considered for the 2014 class.
