



Dear Nursing Applicant:

In an effort to keep our students informed of the admissions requirements as determined by the Health Technologies division, all applicants are **required** to attend a Nursing Admissions Information Session. This session will provide you with valuable information that will assist you with the selective admissions process. It will also allow you to receive the most recent information regarding admissions requirements.

If you have previously attended a session and were placed in an applicant pool for 2013 but were not accepted to a nursing curriculum, you are not automatically placed back into the applicant pool. **In addition to reapplying, you must attend a new session.** If you were in the applicant pool for the 2014 ADN spring program but not accepted, you must reapply and complete a new MAR review to be considered for the 2014 Fall program. You do not need to attend another Nursing Admissions Information Session.
