**Career Description**

This program will prepare you for a leadership or management role in the nonprofit sector, which includes organizations dedicated to helping the disadvantaged, promoting the arts, supporting education, protecting human rights, advancing religion, guarding animal welfare, and other great causes.

**Careers Available**

Graduates should qualify for positions at all levels of leadership and management in the nonprofit sector. Graduates are prepared for employment opportunities in public relations, funds administration, volunteer management, and compliance operations in nonprofit organizations.

**Entry-Level Salary**

\$30,000 - \$35,000/yr.

**Course of Study**

Course work includes an overview of nonprofit organizations (NPO), philanthropy, legal and ethical concerns, funding issues, and strategic planning. Additional coursework introduces grant writing, international non-governmental organizations (NGO), public relations and sustainable communities. Related skills are developed through the study of communications, computer applications, accounting, and other coursework appropriate to the nonprofit sector.

**Recommended Courses and Skills**

Strong human skills and a strong desire to help others will be a plus for the completion of this program. Strong communication, reading comprehension skills and basic computer skills.

**Helpful Personal Attributes**

General awareness of the need to assist those who lack the resources to meet life necessities. Strong communication, human, and interpersonal skills. Analytical and critical thinking skills. Computer keyboarding and technology application abilities and adaptability to various work environments.
