2014 Summer Semester Information Sheet

Deadline: April 14, 2014

If you plan to enroll in classes at Forsyth Technical Community College during the Summer 2014 semester, and you meet the eligibility requirements listed below, you may be awarded financial aid. By signing the form, you acknowledge that you have read and understand the information below.

Eligibility Requirements for Summer Session

In order to be eligible for Summer Semester financial aid, you must:

- Have a valid 2013-2014 FAFSA on file in the Office of Student Financial Services.
- Have submitted all requested financial aid forms to have a completed file in the Office of Student Financial Services.
- **Have remaining eligibility.** *NOTE: If you were enrolled full-time Fall and Spring at any institution, including Forsyth Tech, you may not have any remaining grant eligibility for Summer.*
- Be admitted to or enrolled in a degree, diploma, or eligible certificate program at Forsyth Tech. Special Credit students are not eligible to receive aid.
- Meet the requirements of the Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy for financial aid at the end of the Spring Semester, 2014.
- New students, or returning students after two term absence, will need to update their Admissions application.

Types of Aid Available

Pell Grant – Students who were not full time during the Fall and/or Spring semesters, or did not attend one of these semesters, may be able to receive Pell funds for the summer.

Direct Loans – Students who did not receive the annual loan limit, based on their dependency status and grade level, or who progressed a grade level during the 2013-2014 academic year, may be able to receive additional Direct Loan funds in the summer.

Other Aid - The Office of Student Financial Services will review the student aid account for any other eligible remaining funds and search for additional funds not previously awarded that may be used to assist the student meet the costs of Summer Term. *This does not mean that there are funds available, only that the Office of Student Financial Services will actively search for financial opportunities for each student.*

Deadline

The deadline to submit this completed form to our office is April 14, 2014. Any requests submitted after the deadline will not be processed before the payment deadline, and students will need to pay their tuition and fees to prevent their registration from being cancelled.
