100 – 499	Day Classes (Before 5 PM)
500 – 599	Night Classes (After 5 PM)
600 – 699	CBE Classes (Competency-Based Education): Only available to students in the CBE program.
700 – 749	ITV – Interactive Televideo - Classes are taught via videoconferencing utilizing the Main Campus, Grady Swisher Center, Mazie Woodruff Center, Northwest Forsyth Center, Stokes County, and/or high schools.
750 – 799	Interactive Webconference - Classes are taught using audio headsets and webcams via a Web browser equipped with high speed internet access.
800 – 899	Online – Classes offered 100% via the Internet.
900 – 969	Hybrid – Majority of class is offered via the Internet and remainder face-to-face.
900 – 969	Web Assisted – Primary delivery is via traditional face-to-face method with a requirement that students have Internet access as a supplemental part of the course.
970 – 979	Independent Study – Classes are taught through independent study under special circumstances with the approval of the academic dean.
