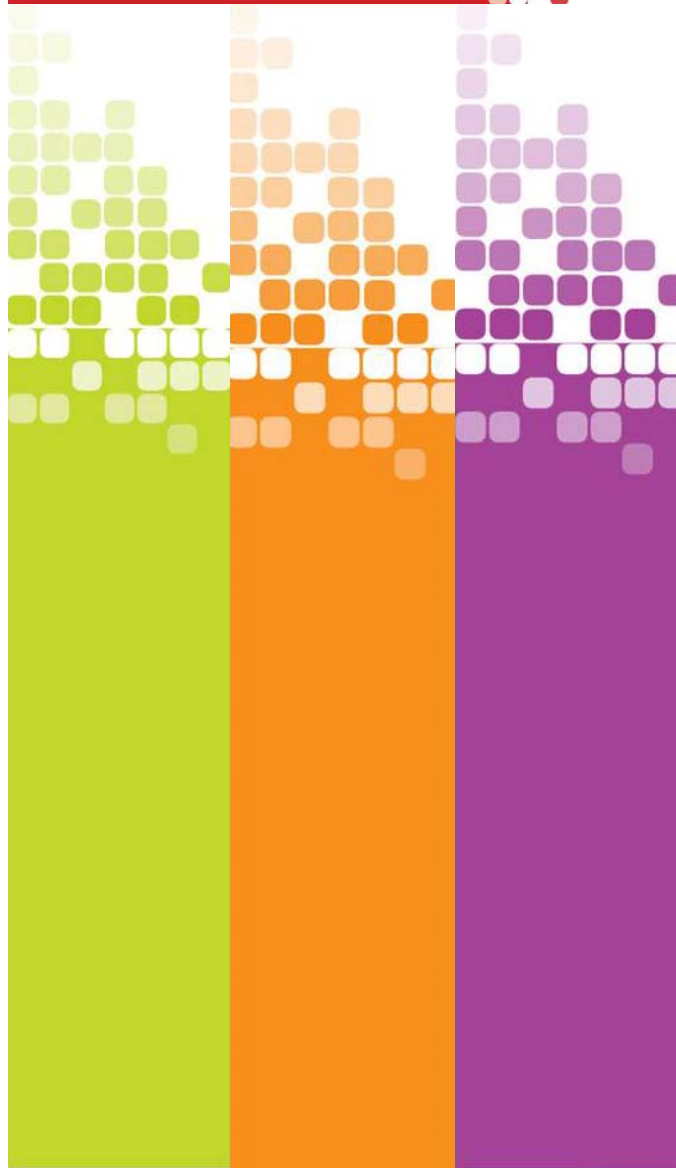

Admission Requirements

1. Complete the Forsyth Tech application.
2. Have an official high school transcript or GED scores mailed to the Admission Office. (Official transcripts must be sent directly from the school to Forsyth Tech and have the school's seal or original signature).
3. Complete placement testing if required by the Admissions Office.
4. Have official transcripts from all colleges or schools attended since high school sent to the Admissions Office. These will be reviewed for possible placement test exemption and transfer credit.
5. Participate in a mandatory Nursing Information Session.
6. Score of 42% percent or higher on the TEAS (Test of Essential Academic Skills).

ALL ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS MUST BE COMPLETED BY MARCH 1, 2012.
