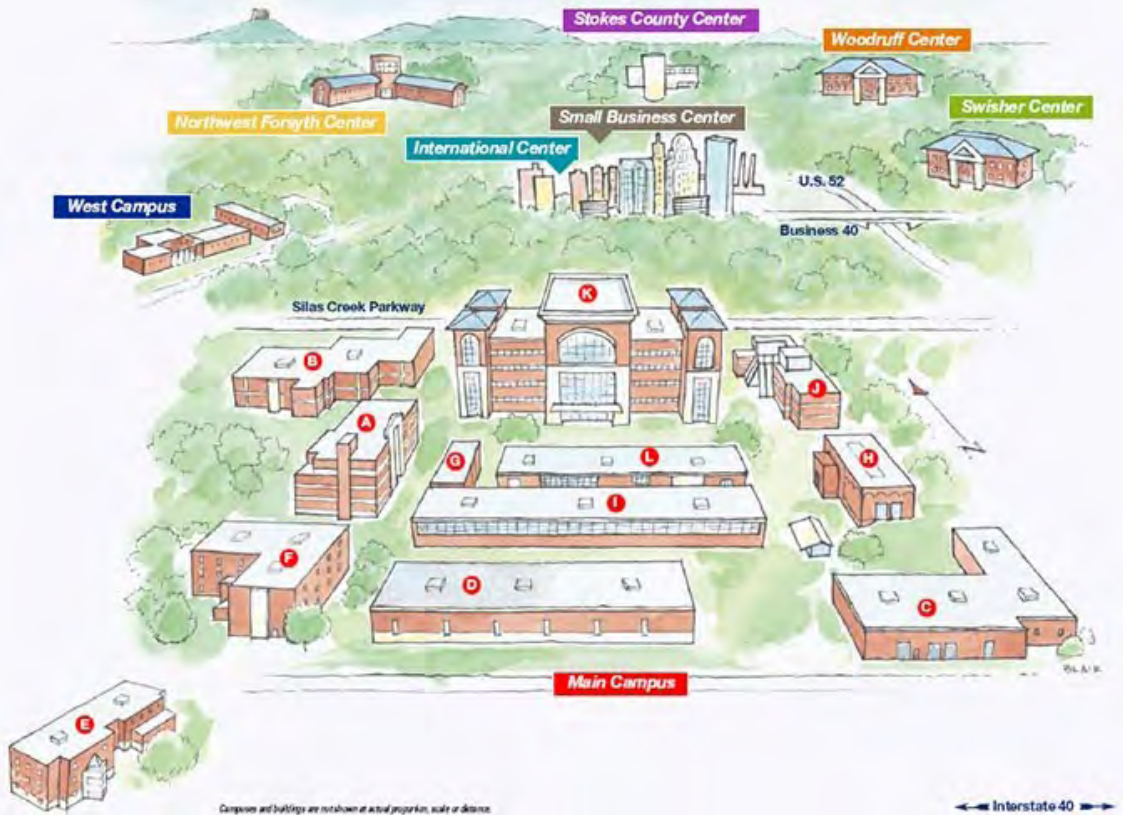

The Forsyth Tech Checklist to Success in Obtaining Financial Aid



1. Apply for admission to Forsyth Tech. This is a separate process from applying for financial aid; however, financial aid cannot be disbursed until you are approved for admission.
2. Complete the [Free Application for Federal Student Aid](#) (FAFSA) as soon as possible after January 1 of the current year you intend to enroll in college.
3. Promptly respond to all requests for information. A checklist letter will be sent to the address on file with Forsyth Tech's Records Office, requesting documents needed to complete your file.
4. If it is determined that you are eligible for aid, you will receive a financial aid award letter, along with several other important documents. Carefully read all materials!
5. Follow-up with your Financial Aid Technician if you have any questions.
