### SCHEDULE of Events

#### REHEARSAL 2:30-3:30 p.m.

All graduates must attend a mandatory rehearsal. Graduates should assemble on the arena level of the coliseum. Important information and instructions will be provided to ensure a successful ceremony. Gold tassels for high honors designation (4.0 GPA) will be distributed at rehearsal to students who have completed all graduation requirements. Please refer to the honors designation information.

#### LINE-UP 3:45 p.m.

Graduates must assemble promptly at 3:45 in your cap and gown at the designated area for your division as instructed at rehearsal. Graduates will receive a color-coded name card to give to their division dean on the stage for announcing graduate information.

#### CEREMONY 5 p.m.

The ceremony will begin promptly at 5 p.m. Invitations/tickets are not required for admission.

**Health Technologies — Gold**  
**Humanities & Social Sciences — Orange**  
**Math, Science & Technologies — Blue**
- > Listen to the instructions given out by the staff.
- > Stay in line.
- > Please exercise patience with the process.



### TIPS for a MEMORABLE COMMENCEMENT

- > Parking is free.
- > Parents/family are to enter through the Main Lobby.
- > Parents/family will not be allowed on the arena floor or the backstage areas.
- > Outside food or drink is not allowed.
- > Concessions will be open from 1 - 5 p.m.
- > Confetti or helium balloons are not allowed in the arena.
- > Video cameras and still photography are allowed.
- > A reserved row in Section 119 allows guests access to American Sign Language interpreting services.
