

Forsyth Tech Study Away Student Conduct Guidelines

Travel and study away is a wonderful and exciting opportunity to learn about other peoples and cultures. While participating in a Forsyth Tech Study Away program, students should remember that they are representatives of their own country as well as our institution. In order to make the most of the study away experience, students must abide by the Forsyth Tech Student Code of Conduct (page 67 in your student handbook), the Study Away Conduct Guidelines (listed below) as well as all rules and regulations set by our host institution.

Any student who engages in conduct unbecoming of Forsyth Tech will be considered in violation and disciplinary action may be taken including dismissal from the program and repatriation at the student's expense.

ALCOHOL, TOBACCO AND DRUGS

The legal age for the use of alcohol or tobacco in the countries/territories visited may vary. Be aware that alcohol abuse will not be tolerated. Violation of local laws and/or program policy may result in immediate dismissal from the program.

- Participants will abide by the laws of the country and/or territory visited.
- Participants will not miss scheduled events because of the effects of alcohol consumption.
- Participants will not become ill due to the effects of alcohol consumption.
- Participants will be respectful of others sharing the same housing, and avoid congregating in loud groups for social purposes.
- Participants will not engage in inappropriate behavior towards others as a result of alcohol consumption.
- Participants will not engage in behavior that is destructive of property as a result of alcohol consumption.
- Participants will not engage in behavior that causes embarrassment to the other members of the group and the in-country hosts as a result of alcohol consumption.
- Participants will not facilitate, encourage, or ignore a fellow participant who is abusing alcohol.

BE RESPONSIBLE.

Forsyth Tech will enforce a zero tolerance policy for drugs and illegal substances.

ATTENDANCE AND PARTICIPATION

Participation is mandatory for all scheduled activities unless otherwise noted. Students are expected to attend all scheduled programs, activities, excursions, and classes. Students are also expected to be punctual and considerate of others. In case of illness, students should notify the program director.

ATTITUDE AND COLLEGIAL BEHAVIOUR

Students are expected to participate enthusiastically and to be respectful and considerate of their fellow participants and directors, as well as program staff.
