Refund Policy

A full refund is given if Forsyth Tech cancels a course. If a course is canceled by Forsyth Tech, parents will be notified by phone and/or e-mail and will receive a 100% refund. Students who withdraw from a course eight calendar days before the first class session are eligible for a full 100% refund, provided they complete and submit a Request for Refund form to the Customer Service Center on West Campus, located at 1300 Bolton Street. After that point, students may get a 50% refund by submitting a Request for Refund form before the first class session.

NOTE: To request a registration fee refund in accordance with the above policy, you must officially withdraw from a course by completing and submitting a Request for Refund form to the Customer Service Center on West Campus, located at 1300 Bolton Street, or you may fill out and submit the online Request for Refund form located at <http://www.forsythtech.edu/courses-programs/job-skills/online-courses/continuing-education-refund-form/>. Refunds are generally mailed within four to six weeks of receipt of the Request for Refund form and/or notification of class cancellation.
