Acrylic Painting Supply list:

Paints:

- Alizarin Crimson
- Cadmium Red Medium
- Lemon Yellow Deep
- Ultramarine Blue
- Thalo Blue (not cerulean)
- Thalo Green (not viridian)
- Titanium White

Brushes:

- Chinese or Nylon bristles
- Long handled "flats"
- ¼ "wide, ½"wide, 1"wide
- Short handled "rounds"
- #1, #10

Medium: Acrylic Gel or Gloss Medium

Palette for color mixing (disposable sheets recommended or white Styrofoam plates)

Small spray bottle

Painting rags or paper towels

Canvas- suggested size: 8"x10", 9"x12", 12"x16", 16"x20"

Choose one large and one small.

Watercolor supply list:

1. 12"x16" Watercolor block (I like "Arches" 120 lb. cold-press)
2. 7 tubes of watercolors, student quality
 - Alizarin Crimson
 - Cadmium red medium
 - Cadmium yellow deep
 - Lemon yellow
 - Thalo Green
 - Thalo Blue
 - Ultra marine Blue
3. 3 Watercolor Brushes
 - One inch wide-flat
 - #10 round
 - #1 round

4. Sea sponge
5. Palette (or white plastic plate)
6. Light pencil (3H) and white eraser
