Student Materials List:

- Pencils /eraser/ Ink pen
- Watercolor paper: Cold pressed, 140 lb.
- Watercolor paint tubes or pans (ivory black, payne's gray, burnt umber, prussian blue, ultramarine blue, cerulean blue, viridian, sap green, crimson red/red medium, vermillion, burnt sienna, yellow ochre, yellow medium, lemon yellow)
- 1 tube of white gouache
- Palette with 6-8 sections (I recommend sealable ones to save paint)
- Brushes in a variety of sizes. Examples: flat and round brushes in sizes 2, 4, 6, 8, 10;
 script liner; mop brush; sumi-e brush; hake brush
- Water container / sea sponge
- Several bulldog clips
- Hard board to mount paper (back of a canvas panel or stiff cardboard works well)
- Masking tape
- Cloths for blotting brushes
- Note/sketching paper

- Travel watercolor sketchbook
- White gel pen
- Tabletop easel
