100 – 299	Main Campus- Includes face-to-face and blended sections
300 – 399	Center Locations- Includes face-to-face and blended sections
600 – 699	CBE Classes (Competency-Based Education) - Only available to students in the CBE program.
700 – 749	Video Conference- Classes are taught via synchronous videoconferencing.
750 – 799	Online Synchronous- Classes are taught at a <u>set meeting time</u> using audio headsets and webcams using online delivery method.
800 – 899	Online Asynchronous- Classes offered 100% via the Internet with <u>no set meeting time</u> .
900 – 969	Hybrid- Classes are partial via the Internet and partially face-to-face.
970 – 979	Independent Study- Classes are taught through independent study under special circumstances with the approval of the academic dean.
