

INTRODUCTION

All traffic rules and regulations have been approved by the board of trustees and filed with the North Carolina Secretary of State as required by N.C. General Statute 115D-21.

These rules apply to all students, faculty, staff and others who drive and park on Forsyth Technical Community College property.



preserving peace, order and a safe educational environment; upholding the policies of Forsyth Tech: and enforcing local, state and federal laws. Sworn officers have full arrest power established by NCGS 115D-21.1.

Vehicle Registration and Parking Permits

Police

All students, faculty and staff who park vehicles on Forsyth Tech campuses must register their vehicles and purchase a parking decal.

- Rear View > A vehicle is not considered registered until the decal Decal Placement is properly displayed on the vehicle.
- > Parking decals must be affixed to the outside left rear window or left bumper. > Clean area before applying decal to vehicle.
- > Parking decals are not transferable to another vehicle.
- > For special situations, contact the Campus Police Department. If all classes are online, you are not required to purchase a decal.

Temporary Permits - Persons who must drive a different vehicle for a short period of time may obtain a temporary permit from the Campus Police Office on Main Campus at no cost. Temporary permits may be obtained at the customer service areas at the Northwest Center, Transportation Technology Center, West Campus, Mazie S. Woodruff Center or Grady P. Swisher Center. Obtaining a temporary permit requires a valid driver's license and the make, model and license tag number of the vehicle. A current decal on file is needed to obtain a temporary permit. Only three two-week permits may be obtained in a semester.

Violations & Fines

There will be a **\$25 fine** for parking in a handicap space without a valid state permit or for parking along a curb.

There is a \$5 fine for each of the following violations:

> Improperly registered vehicle

- > Decal improperly displayed
- > Student parking in staff or visitor lots
- > Failure to comply
- > Parking in staff lot before 5:30 p.m. or parking in "reserved spaces
- > Driving in or out of any one way driveway
- > Other state enforced traffic violations

All fines must be paid to Forsyth Tech.

Fines may be paid at the Cashiers Office in Allman Center, Main Campus or off campus sites that sell parking decals:

Monday Thursday 8:30 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Off campus hours: 8:30 a.m. 5 p.m.

Friday 8:30 a.m. to 2 p.m.

General Information

- > Parking in staff and visitor lots for students is permitted after 5:30 p.m. (Main Campus only).
- > For parking decal cost, visit www.forsythtech.edu/parkingdecal
- > Decals are not refundable.
- > It is unlawful to operate a motor vehicle on campus at a speed in excess of 15 mph.
- > Forsyth Tech assumes no responsibility for damage to any vehicle or for the contents of the vehicle while it is parked or being operated on campus.
- > A parking decal does not guarantee or reserve a parking space.
- > All individuals are responsible for tickets placed on their vehicle regardless of who is operating the vehicle at the time of the infraction.
- > Decal is required by the first day of class.
- > Report ALL accidents or crimes on campus to the Campus Police Department.
- > Motorcycles and bicycles are to be parked in designated areas ONLY.
- > Visitor parking (Lot B) is for visitors only, unless after 5:30 p.m., even when not in class and on campus or driving an unregistered vehicle.
- > Reserved parking spaces are restricted per signs.
- > Faculty and staff can park in student parking.
