



FAA Part 65 Accelerated Prep Program

STEPS TO REGISTER AND QUALIFICATION ELIGIBILTY

The applicant must determine eligibility by completing the following:

Military - Verify MOS qualification <u>Figure 5-13Military Occupational Specialty Codes</u>

Civilian - Verify Years of Service Qualification (Civilian OJT and logbook entries to qualify)

- 1. FAA 8610 Sign-Off Qualifications Form <u>Airman Certificate & / Or Rating Application</u>
- 2. Register with IACRA https://iacra.faa.gov/IACRA/Default.aspx
- 3. Prior to your FAA interview, gather your documented evidence of experience with the FAA FISDO to create an FAA interview package
- 4. Set up an interview with FAA to review your 8610 application and documentation for a sign-off to be eligible to take FAA mechanic test. Make an interview appointment with FAA FSDO Greensboro, NC 336-369-3900
- 5. Complete your FAA 8610 Interview
- 6.Recommended purchase of Dauntless Aviation or ASA Prepware for Mechanic General, Airframe, Powerplant School
- 7.Register with FAAPSIEXAMS.com to schedule exams. https://faa.psiexams.com/faa/login
- 8. Take FAA Knowledge Tests. Prospective students must have a minimum of 70 on their written exams prior to registering for the FT Part 65 course. FT Program Coordinator recommends achieving an 80 score.
- 9. Prior to registering for the course, schedule a meeting with the Program Coordinator to review your qualifications, experience, and required FAA documents.
