**Educational Preparation:** The Automotive Systems Technology program prepares students to diagnose, service, and repair modern automobiles. Students receive hands-on training in electrical and electronic systems, engine performance, brake systems, steering and suspension, and climate control. The curriculum follows the standards of the National Institute for Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) and supports preparation for ASE certification exams.

**Licensure and Certification:** While state licensure is not typically required for general automotive technicians, ASE certification is nationally recognized and often preferred by employers. In some states, additional certification may be required for emissions testing or air conditioning services. Students should consult their state’s motor vehicle or environmental regulatory agency for specific requirements.
