Program Overview: The Health Information Technology program at Forsyth Technical Community College prepares students to collect, manage, and analyze health data in both digital and paper-based systems. The curriculum includes instruction in medical coding, health care reimbursement, privacy and security, electronic health records, and health data management. Graduates are eligible to sit for the Registered Health Information Technician (RHIT) credential exam offered by the American Health Information Management Association (AHIMA).

Certification and State Recognition: While the RHIT credential is nationally recognized, some states or employers may have additional requirements related to licensure, background checks, or continuing education. Individuals are encouraged to consult their state's health department or licensing board for specific employment eligibility requirements.
