Educational Preparation: Forsyth Technical Community College’s MRI program trains students in advanced imaging techniques and prepares them for the ARRT post-primary certification in Magnetic Resonance Imaging.

Licensure and Certification: While many states do not require MRI licensure, national certification through ARRT is widely recognized and often required by employers. Some states may require additional licensing or registry with a state health agency. Students should research the radiologic health board in their intended state of employment to ensure compliance with all local requirements.
