Educational Preparation: Forsyth Technical Community College’s Medical Coding program prepares students to translate healthcare diagnoses and procedures—using ICD-10-CM, CPT®, and HCPCS Level II—into standardized codes for billing, insurance, and statistical analysis. The curriculum also emphasizes compliance with HIPAA and other relevant regulations.

Certification and State Requirements: While medical coders are not licensed by states, employers typically require certification through organizations such as AAPC (Certified Professional Coder – CPC) or AHIMA (Certified Coding Associate – CCA). Students should verify which credential is preferred in their desired healthcare setting or geographic region.

Professional Development: Once certified, coders must earn continuing education units (CEUs) annually or biennially to maintain their credentials through AAPC or AHIMA. Forsyth Tech supports students with exam prep resources, career services, and connections to internships or externships to help launch their career.
