WEEK ONE	» Drafting the design. Bring inspiration photos, artwork and imagery » Cutting the Grooves. After applying the adhesive, cut the channels into the foam. » Selecting Fabric. Choose fabric for each section of the design- consider color, value and print.	Supplies you WILL need: (Please bring to the first class.) » Pencil » Scrap Paper » Fine Tip Sharpie » Good Fabric Scissors » Fabric Scraps (Natural fibers suggested) » Seam Ripper with a comfortable handle
WEEK TWO to FOUR	» Complete Fabric Selection. Choose fabric for each section of the design- consider color, value and print. » Attaching and Tucking Fabric. Begin attaching the fabric and tucking into the channels	(Please make sure you get the proper items.) » 1" insulation foam 12 x 12 recommended- the pink board works best https://amzn.to/4v9OvaV » Double Sided Adhesive Sheet 3m or similar https://amzn.to/3R9I9eN (A kit will be available for purchase with these two items for \$26.
